Built originally as a private house/hunting lodge at around 1800 and transformed into the building you see today at around 1850.

The hotel has a great history, as guests you will be in good company with many famous people throughout history having been to the hotel to name drop a few - King George V, Russian Royalty, J.J. Sainsbury, Churchill and General Eisenhower.

The building was commandeered during both World Wars. During World War One the hotel was used as a field hospital. Some still remember injured soldiers being wheeled on luggage trolleys from Brockenhurst Train Station to the hotel! In the Second World War the Hotel was transformed into an Army Staff College. Some of the "Orders for the Day" were issued from the hotel for the "D Day" invasion. During our extensive refurbishment of the hotel, we frequently find spent ammunition under the floorboards.

The early years of the hotel's history was spent in private ownership. After the Second World War it was part of Myddleton Hotels and was in good company with sister hotel, the Royal Bath in Bournemouth. In 1979 the hotel was acquired by the Ladbroke Group and latterly became an Associate Hilton Hotel.

In October 1997 the hotel once again returned to private ownership. The Wilson family are now the proud owners of the hotel and have worked hard to completely refurbish the property and return to its former glory as the best four-star hotel in the New Forest.

A TOP-DRAWER ENGLISH SPARKLING WINE PRODUCER

The Liddell family have farmed at Cottonworth, in the Test Valley, for five generations. They planted their first vines in 2005, and the vineyard has grown ever since, along with Cottonworth's reputation as a top-drawer sparkling wine producer. Before that, Hugh Liddell, who runs the wine side of the farm, worked and studied in Burgundy, and has since done vintages in South Africa and New Zealand as well as gaining a viticulture and oenology degree from Plumpton College, allowing him to be fully hands-on in the production of these exceptional wines.



Drappier is a household name in France. Eighth generation family business, founded in 1808. Over half of Drappier's production comes from the family's own vineyards near their base in Urville. Viticulture is close to organic; they have always worked sustainably and are the first Champagne House to be carbon neutral.

PROSECCO EXTRA DRY, SERENA 1881 Veneto, Italy

Fresh and elegant, this Prosecco has bright acidity, with notes of crisp apples, pears, citrus and white flowers.

PROSECCO ROSÉ, SERENA 1881 Veneto, Italy

Delicate pink in colour, with aromas of summer berries! The Serena 1881 Rosé has a fine mousse, with flavours of strawberries and orchard fruits on the refreshing palate.

COTTONWORTH CLASSIC CUVÉE Hampshire, England

Refined, creamy sparkling wine that offers a brilliant balance between chalky, fruity/floral and yeasty, bread notes. The mousse is extremely fine and the palate dry without being austere. With impressive richness on the finish, this is one of England's

CHAMPAGNE DRAPPIER BRUT 1ER CRU Champagne, France

A Pinot Noir-based champagne of real elegance, offering intense aromas of pear, vanilla and a touch of spice. The dry, fresh palate shows toasty notes with lingering flavours of hazelnuts on the intense finish.

CHAMPAGNE DRAPPIER BLANC DE BLANCS BRUT Champagne, France

A classic blanc de blancs, all about delicacy and finesse, with the typical white peach and apple aromas of Chardonnay lifted by a touch of floral Pinot Blanc. Lightly biscuity on the palate, with great freshness and purity.

BOLLINGER SPECIAL CUVÉE Champagne, France

Aromatic complexity with hints of roasted apples, compote and peaches and spice with a pear and brioche palate showing length and vivacity and bubbles like velvet...

LAURENT-PERRIER ROSÉ Champagne, France

Elegant, with colour changing naturally from a pretty raspberry hue to salmon pink. A precise nose of extraordinary freshness and a wide range of red fruits: raspberry, redcurrant, strawberry and black cherry. A fresh and sharp attack for this supple and rounded wine. On the palate, it offers the sensation of plunging into a basket of freshly picked red berries.

MEZZACORONA

Terre del Noce produce fresh, appealing varietal wines from the Dolomite foothills around Arco, north of Lake Garda. The vines are grown and the wines made by Mezzacorona, which explains the superb quality. Mezzacorona has a state-of-the-art winery handling estate-grown fruit from the company's extensive vineyard holdings in the heart of the Dolomites.



Matetic vineyards embody the pioneering spirit and vision of modern Chilean winemaking. This biodynamic project was founded in 1999 by the Matetic family. Already established as farmers with extensive landholdings, the fourth generation of the family turned their attention to grapes. Confident of the attributes of the climate and soils in the coastal VI Rosario Salley of San Antonio, they planted 120 hectares of vines, and now farm 160 hectares of coastal biodynamic vineyard.

A MODERN WINE WITH ANCIENT ROOTS

Piero Broglia released his first wine from his father's La Meirana estate in 1974, but there is a record of vines at the property that dates back to 971 AD, the very beginning of the story of Gavi. An MP with a law degree, Piero is a born researcher, having provided Italy's first register of satellite-mapped vineyards, in Gavi, and carried out a study into clones of Cortese, the local vine.

Red Wine



Since 1898, the **JOUBERT FAMILY** have been the custodians of the Klein Simonsvlei farm in Paarl. Now under the watchful eye of Niel's son Dan and using only grapes from their own farm, they continue to produce fantastic fruit-driven wines, with true varietal character.



Château Ksara is Lebanon's oldest working winery. It is situated in the heart of the Bekaa Valley, Lebanon's pre-eminent wine producing region. Winemaking began in 1857 when the 27 hectares estate was inherited by Jesuit monks. In 1898, the chance discovery of an old Roman grotto, stretching over two kilometres in length, provided an ideal cellar. Château Ksara has grown to 440 hectares today, split over 10 different vineyards all within the Bekaa Valley.

Dr Bailey Carrodus helped re-establish the Yarra Valley as one of Australia's pre-eminent wine regions. After several years of careful research, in 1969 he purchased land at the foot of the Warramate Hills, and in 1973 produced the first vintages of his iconic Dry Red Wine No.1 and Dry Red Wine No.2. Dr Carrodus continued to make the wines until his death in 2008, when the winery was purchased by businessmen Ed Peter and Reid Bosward. Both long-term fans of Yarra Yering, they continue to honour the founder's quest for elegance and sophistication, ably supported by winemaker Sarah Crowe, who in 2017 was named Winemaker of the Year by James Halliday.
